

NanoICT project launches exchange visits for PhD students (or senior research personnel)

Madrid, Spain 8th October 2010

Main objectives:

- To perform joint work or to be trained in the leading European industrial and academic research institutions
- To enhance long-term collaborations within the ERA
- To generate high-skilled personnel and to facilitate technology transfer
- In all respects, these training activities are an important element in networking

Conditions:

- 1.500€ (maximum) per visit to cover travel and accommodation expenses
- Applicants must be students or research personnel working in any registered nanoICT group

- Destination groups must be as well a nanoICT registered group

- Duration of the visit, one week minimum
- After the visit, a scientific summary report must be delivered (to be published in the E-Nano Newsletter,
<http://www.phantomsnet.net/Foundation/newsletters.php>, thus no copyright will be requested)
- The nanoICT Management Board will award grants for this activity on a competitive basis
- Priority will be given to women and ERA cross border applications
- Funding will be available only for personnel belonging to European groups

- Affiliation
- Brief CV
- Destination institution/company
- Duration of the visit
