




This flyer (October 2015), compiled by the Phantoms Foundation, provides a general overview of the graphene related companies (23) in Spain.

The second version of the report "Nanoscience & Nanotechnology in Spain" (2010/2011) provides insights by identifying R&D directions and priorities in Spain. Moreover, it aims to be a valid source of guidance, not only for the scientific community but also for the industry. This report covers a wide range of interdisciplinary areas of research and development, such as Graphene, Nanochemistry, Nanomedicine, Carbon Nanotubes, Nanomaterials for Energy, Modelling, etc., and provides insights in these areas, currently very active worldwide and particularly in Spain.
